

Empowering Atlanta's Children for a Bright Future

Quality Education and the Necessary Skills

We understand that Atlanta faces unique challenges when it comes to breaking the cycle of poverty - especially for its youth. That's why we have dedicated a significant portion of our community resources towards supporting children and education.

As a young company, our community journey began with Centennial Academy, a K-8 STEM-focused conversion charter school on the edge of Midtown and down the street from the Georgia Aquarium. It sits on the grounds of the former Techwood Homes public housing community, which was one of the nation's first public housing projects. On a daily basis, our employees went into the schools to tutor students - primarily in grades 3-5, when reading comprehension skills and math skills are critical to charting future success.

The neighborhood was thoughtfully redeveloped with desirable multifamily housing in time for the 1996 Olympics. It was a striking example of urban renewal. The school and a new YMCA were the crown jewels of the neighborhood. Today, Centennial Place is a vibrant mixed-income neighborhood by design – but it is also adjacent to several transitional housing shelters that feed into the school. The school is also landlocked by new development on highly coveted parcels of land.


Posse Atlanta
